
















One day this summer, one of the godfathers of visionary architecture payed a visit to our studio in Berlin. Dennis Crompton - member and archivist of the group archigram. Amazing, fanciful, quixotic. Undoubtfully they are among our architect-heroes. Dennis talked with us about the scrapyard of visions, the city as responsive system, interactive buildings, good intentions, imaginary cities and the art of architecture that cannot fail. Stick on city is a responsive drawing, made to be permanently renewed. It is a 12mx2,5m training ground for utopians.
